Re: Updated Medical First Responder (MFR) Consumables Policy Directive

To: PEI Firefighters Association and MFR Participating Agencies registered by PEI Firefighters Association

We would like to bring to your awareness an update we've made to the MFR Consumables Policy Directive at the request of Island EMS. As a reminder, the attached policy directive reflects a longstanding policy to promote participation in the MFR program by offsetting the costs to participating agencies associated with the required medical supplies. The EHS Division will continue to provide funding to address replacement costs for the emergency medical equipment and consumable supplies defined by the policy. Please note that fire departments should obtain replacement oxygen D tanks from Island Oxygen as outlined in Appendix A.

Given the minor changes in the policy directive from the previous version it is effective immediately. Please review the attached and distribute within your organization. Do not hesitate to contact our office with questions or concerns.
