Will have to hire WeldTech to join the two together. This is part of the Level II as well as possibly being stand alone.
- ✘ Rope course for May. There are a number of people who want the next level but can't do it in May or June, Equinox is coming in July for Level III and can take care of the others at the same time. This will be considered but to make collecting from no-shows easier, payment in advance will be considered.
- ✘ Wedges and plugs here for HazMat team. HazMat will be doing practice/demonstration March 20th at Charlottetown, Station 2.
