PEI MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDERS

Level 1

Response Criteria: Respond to all code 1 calls.

Level 2

Response Criteria: Respond to calls that fall under defined criteria for their jurisdiction.

- Carbon monoxide/Inhalation/Hazmat
- Allergic Reactions
- Stroke/CVA
- Cardiac Arrest
- Choking
- Drowning
- Accidents: Traffic/Industrial
- Electrocution
- Unconscious/Unknown Life Status

Level 3

Response Criteria: Respond when requested by paramedics or when there is expected to be a delayed response.

Level 4.1

Response Criteria: Respond to code 1 calls when ambulance response time is expected to be greater than 10 minutes.

Level 4.2

Response Criteria: Respond to code 1 calls that fall under the Level 2 Criteria when the ambulance response time is expected to be greater than 10 minutes.
