Lights and Sirens

Level 2

RESPONSE CRITERIA

Respond to defined criteria for emergency medical call
in their Jurisdiction

- Carbon Monoxide/Inhalation/Hazmat
- Allergic Reactions
- Stroke/CVA
- Cardiac Arrest
- Choking

- Drowning / Scuba
- Accident / Unconscious/Unknown Life Status
- Electrocutions
- Industrial / Machinery accidents (incl. Farms)
- Traffic Accidents: Injuries
 - Multiple Victims
 - Major Incidents
 - High Mechanism
 - Hazmat
 - Trapped/Pinned
 - Not Alert/Ineffective Breathing

Level 3

RESPONSE CRITERIA

Respond when requested by paramedics or when
there is an expected prolonged response

Level 4.1 /4.2

Response Criteria

Respond to Level 1 or 2 Criteria if ambulance will be
More the 10 minutes (Exemptions Cardiac or
Respiratory Arrest – Notify regardless)
