COURSE OFFERED: EV 200 – **Defensive Driving Training**: Coaching Emergency Vehicle Operations, 3<sup>rd</sup> Edition- Fire Certificate issued by National Safety Council. Air Brake review, practical driving and obstacle course.

Students will have both classroom and practical training with a National Safety Council course. An air brake review is completed. This course will deal with speed, cornering and stopping distances when operating heavy vehicles. The obstacle course will teach how to operate heavy vehicles in restricted or tight spaces. The course test is administered by the P.E.I. FFA, but the marking and issued certificates are completed by the National Safety Council.
